This one-week, intensive doctoral course will familiarize students with selected parts of the large (and growing) literature about financial intermediary firms. Both theoretical and empirical papers will be considered. Students will have the opportunity (though not an obligation) to present their own work at special afternoon sessions of the course.

The main topics are:

1. Banking firms' value added in financial markets
2. Customer relationships
3. Financial structure; government supervision of private banking firms
4. Risk management techniques, services, and value
5. Securitization of bank assets
6. Bank financing and corporation finance
